

1. I Thessalonians 2:17-20 But, brothers and sisters, when we were orphaned by being separated from you for a short time (in person, not in thought), out of our intense longing we made every effort to see you. ¹⁸ For we wanted to come to you - certainly I, Paul, did again and again but Satan blocked our way. ¹⁹ For what is our hope, our joy, or the crown in which we will glory in the presence of our Lord Jesus when he comes? Is it not you? ²⁰ Indeed, you are our glory and joy.

A. What does Paul call the Christians in Thessalonica (verse 17)? How do you think he fells about them?

B. What three things does Paul call the Christians in Thessalonica in verse 19? How does Paul think he'll feel about them when Christ returns?

2. 1 Corinthians 1:9 God is faithful, who has called you into fellowship with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

A. What does this verse tell us about the day Christ returns?

B. Compare this verse to Isaiah 64:4. How has Paul slightly changed the verse in 1 Corinthians? What significance do you think this might have?

3. Acts 17:1-10 When Paul and his companions had passed through Amphipolis and Apolonia, they came to Thessalonica, where there was a Jewish synagogue ² As was his custom, Paul went into the synagogue, and on three Sabbath days he reasoned with them from the Scriptures. explaining and proving that the Messiah had to suffer and rise from the dead. "This Jesus I am proclaiming to you is the Messiah." he said. ⁴ Some of the Jews were persuaded and joined Paul and Silas, as did a large number of God-fearing Greeks and guite a few prominent women. ⁵ But other Jews were jealous: so they rounded up some bad characters from the marketplace, formed a mob and started a riot in the city. They rushed to Jason's house in search of Paul and Silas in order to bring them out to the crowd. 6 But when they did not find them, they dragged Jason and some other believers before the city officials, shouting: "These men who have caused trouble all over the world have now come here. ⁷ and Jason has welcomed them into his house. They are all defying Caesar's decrees, saying that there is another king, one called Jesus. 8 When they heard this the crowd and the city officials were thrown into turmoil. 9 Then they made Jason and the others post bond and let them go. 10 As soon as it was night, the believers sent Paul and Silas away to Berea. On arriving there, they went to the Jewish synagogue.

A. What do you learn about the birth of the church in Thessalonica?

B. What clues do you get from this text about the difficulties the Thessalonians faced in their newfound faith? How can their experience help and encourage us today?
