Listen to Dr. Oaks, as he shares how this message might well apply to your life and mine.

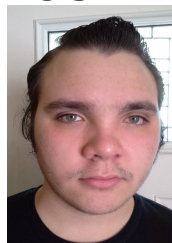

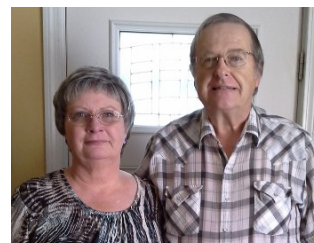
